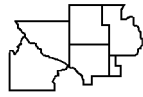

Hearing & Service Dogs of Minnesota...

Our speaker this month is from *Hearing and Service Dogs of Minnesota*. Also joining us will be a “graduate” from the course.

Hearing and Service Dogs of Minnesota is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for people who are deaf, hard of hearing or disabled by creating mutually beneficial partnerships with specially trained dogs.

Hearing and Service Dogs of Minnesota works with individuals who are deaf, hard-of-hearing or physically disabled, pairing them with dogs specially trained to alert them to important sounds or assist them in the activities of daily living. In general, these animals are referred to as assistance dogs.

Lions have long supported Hearing and Service Dogs of Minnesota and currently provide 20 percent or more of our annual income. All assistance dogs are provided to the client at no charge —

\$5,000 sponsors a Hearing Dog

\$10,000 sponsors a Service Dog

The cost per graduated team is more than \$28,000
